**SS 946.72 Tampering with public records and notices.**

- (1) Whoever with intent to injure or defraud destroys, damages, removes or conceals any public record is guilty of a Class H felony.
- (2) Conviction of a Class H felony is punishable by up to six (6) years imprisonment and/or a fine of \$10,000.00

Discussions took place regarding the upcoming restructuring of HWY V from I 43 to HWY R.

It was suggested that reconstruction of some curbing and curbing apron will be needed to meet road grades which will help to divert the water. Mr. Pravechek was informed that he would be fully assessed for any work done to the existing curb or any new curbing requested by him to be added to his property. Village Engineer Paul Steinbrecker from SMI will handle the bidding process for work to be done on the Pravachek property.
