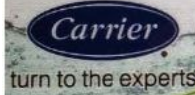

## Updates from the Village Clerk

A few updates before the newsletter takes a break for the summer:

1. **Sewer Bills**—On your bill there is a notice referencing the Governors Emergency Order #11. This order specifically relates to utility billing. How this affects you:
  - Late fees for first quarter were suspended. If you have yet to pay your first quarter sewer bill, it will appear on the second quarter bill but you will not be charged a late fee.
  - Deferred payment agreements and budget billing arrangements for customers who request them. If you have been impacted financially by the COVID-19 pandemic and are having difficulty paying your sewer bill please call the Village Office at 920-682-7410 and the clerk will work out a plan with you. These will not be applied to all accounts by default. YOU MUST CALL to participate.
  
2. **Village Website**—If you have gone to the Village website recently, you'll notice a different look. We've updated the website and are working to update the content.
  
3. **Pla-Mor Park and the Devil's River State Trail**—Both the Village park and the State Trail remain open. Please make sure you practice social distancing when visiting those places. The playground at Pla-Mor park is open again but it is use at your own risk, equipment is not sanitized. The restrooms will remain closed indefinitely.
  
4. **Need Help?**—If you or anyone else in the community is struggling to get supplies or essentials, please don't hesitate to reach out. We're all in this together.
  
5. **Spread the Love Hearts**—While wandering the Village we've been seeing more and more hearts in our neighborhood windows and doors. It is part of the #spreadthelove campaign during this global health crisis. Since COVID-19 has become a part of our everyday lives, people have been hanging the hearts to share the love they have for friends, family, and loved ones they can't see while settling into this new "normal".
