**FRANCIS CREEK VILLAGE REGULAR BOARD MEETING

**Call to Order:**

**Pledge of Allegiance:** Everyone present stood to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Corrections, Additions, Approval of Meeting Minutes from September 9, 2019:** Motion by Robert Dirkman to approve the minutes from the September 9, 2019 meeting. Second by Eric Nelson. Motion carried unanimously.

**Approval of Agenda:** Motion was made by Steve Holschbach to approve the Agenda, second by Robert Dirkman. All in favor, motion carried unanimously.

**Public Input:** Gale and Joann Fenlon (Forest Home Drive) – There are a lot of deer in the village and they are a nuisance to the residents. Would the board consider a bow season or some kind of solution to manage the deer population. The board explained that per village ordinance there is no use of firearms within the village, that includes bow and arrow. The board would have to modify the ordinance to allow some kind of exception. Probably isn't feasible this year but the board would look into what that would take.

Ryan Koch (French Creek Road) and August Richter (Memory Lane) – Both residents are frustrated with the construction that took place on Memory Lane and French Creek Road. It is a major nuisance for them to have the incomplete road in front of their driveways. Since the construction had unforeseen complications more pavement needed to be removed than originally planned. The board will look into a solution to be installed.

**The Clerk to submit invoices and payroll to be approved and paid for the month:** Board reviewed and approved invoices and payroll.

**Village Update since Last Meeting:** Matt Payette was able to acquire an LIP for Village Road Improvement.

**Sewer Update since Last Meeting:** Water totals for the month were high because of the amount of rain. The lift station grinder is in need of repairs which will be worked on over the coming month.
