Partial Job Description:

- daily bathroom cleaning, emptying garbage cans and filling dispensers
- weekly weed and grass trimming
- grass cutting using Large Commercial Mowers
- daily preparation of ball diamonds for games
- general care of park facilities
- collection of garbage and take to recycling center Wednesday
- painting
- weeding flower gardens and maintaining bark around trees and play equipment
- miscellaneous items

Must be 18 years of age or older, able to work with minimal supervision, have a current driver's license and be insurable for driving. Must be reliable, self-motivated, and dependable. Starting wage is \$9.75 per hour.
