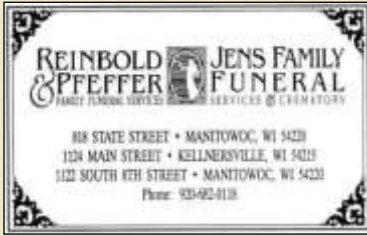

Diabetes Alert Day

America Diabetes Association (ADA) Alert Day is observed annually on the 4th Tuesday in March, which is March 27th this year. This one-day "wake-up call" is to inform the American public about the seriousness of the disease and to find out if they are at risk for developing type 2 diabetes.

According to the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases, diabetes affects about 30.3 million Americans or about 9.4 percent of the U.S. population. It's also estimated that 1 in every 4 persons with diabetes are unaware that they have the disease. If you have a family history of diabetes, you have a greater risk of developing type 2 diabetes.
