

A Message from the Clerk!

- Spring has sprung officially and we just want to remind residents of our <u>ATV/UTV Ordinances</u> and our <u>Golf Cart Ordinances</u> for the Village streets.
- Dog Licensing—Notices will be going out in the mail to individuals who have yet to license their dogs for 2023. Licenses can be obtained in the Village Office, owners must provide proof of rabies vaccination.
- The Laurel/Lilac/Cherry road reconstruction project scope and timeline has changed. During the preparation televising of the Village Sewer on those roads certain issues arose and after discussion with the Village engineer it was decided that the sewer running under Laurel and Cherry would be replaced. Specific timelines and bid information will be discussed at the June 5th Village Board meeting and will be shared then.
- As part of our water permit with the WI DNR they are asking the Village to collect the last time each residents water softener was serviced. Cards are available during the in the Office for residents to fill out. Please help us maintain our permit with the DNR and share your water softener information. Also don't forget about the <u>water softener rebate program</u> if you are replacing your water softener to receive a \$100 cash rebate from the Village!
- Keep your eyes and ears open for the Lakeshore Knights Car Show coming to the Village July 29th. The Francis Creek Lion's Club will be running the concession stand at the event.
- Mark your calendars, the Francis Creek Fire Department Truck Pulls will be Friday, July 14th. Head out and support the FCFD!
