#### Statewide, Referendum Question I - Vote Yes or No

Conditions of release before convictions. Shall section 8 (2) of article I of the constitution be amended to allow a court to impose on an accused person being released before conviction conditions that are designed to protect the community from serious harm?

#### Statewide, Referendum Question II - Vote Yes or No

Cash bail before conviction. Shall section 8 (2) of article I of the constitution be amended to allow a court to impose cash bail on a person accused of a violent crime based on the totality of the circumstances, including the accused's previous convictions for a violent crime, the probability that the accused will fail to appear, the need to protect the community from serious harm and prevent witness intimidation, and potential affirmative defenses?

# A Message from the Clerk!

- Laurel/Lilac/Cherry Road Project Update—As the project was progressing the Village had Northern Pipe do cleaning and televising of the sanitary sewer and the storm sewer to see if any repairs were needed while the road would be torn out. The storm sewer system looked good but unfortunately the sanitary sewer system that is the original system from the '60's/'70's is quite corroded. After receiving the estimated cost to do a relining coating on the system totaling more than \$100,000 (roughly \$60/linear foot) the board decided to replace the system rather than repair which is roughly \$72-89/linear foot (based off of estimates from bided projects from other municipalities). This has obviously changed the project and therefore the project timeline. We are waiting for the engineering from McMahon on the utility work and will share a timeline when we have one. Any questions can be directed to the Village Office.
- Dog Licensing—Licenses were DUE by **April 1st, 2023**, all late liceses will be charged an additional late fee of \$10.00 for each dog. Wisconsin State Statute Chapter 174 states that the owner of a dog more than 5 months of age within the license year, shall pay the dog license tax and obtain a license. Please be a responsible pet owner and have your dog licensed as soon as possible. If licensing by mail, please include a self-addressed envelope with postage.
- As part of our water permit with the WI DNR they are asking the Village to collect the last time each residents water softener was serviced. Cards will be available during the April 4th election in the Office for residents to fill out. Please help us maintain our permit with the DNR and share your water softener information.
