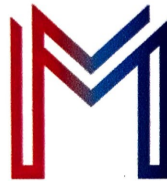

## A Message from the Clerk!

- Copies of our [ATV/UTV Ordinances](#) and our [Golf Cart Ordinances](#) for the Village streets.
- At the July 10th meeting the board awarded MC Excavating, LLC the 2023 portion of the Lilac, Laurel, Cherry Road Reconstruction Project. Their bid of \$421,330.53 was nearly \$88,000 lower than the next highest bid from De Groot, Inc.

This portion of the project includes the sanitary sewer replacement, installation of the storm sewer, and road reconstruction/grading. A tentative start date is set for just after Labor Day in September and take approximately 7-12 weeks. Sewer work should take about 4 weeks, road work roughly 3 weeks. Once the timeline is confirmed it will be posted and shared out with residence.

*\*Note: The second half of the project that includes the curb & gutter and road finishing will be bid out in early 2024 to be completed ASAP Spring 2024. This decision was made to allow the road to settle over the winter and prevent the dips similar to what currently is on the road.*

- The Village staff has been hard at work in Pla-Mor Park working on our summer projects. Thanks to Hallman Lindsay Paints of Manitowoc donating over \$500 worth of paint our bleachers are getting a fresh coat of stain!
